All acceptable documents are listed below; only the original or certified copy (if stated below) will be accepted. All documents must be valid (**not expired**). ID combination choices are:

2. One ID from each list "A" and "C"

1. One ID from each list "A" and "B"

3. One ID from each list "B" and "C"

Required ID Examples itemized by your status in the US: "Non-drivers may supply an ID card in lieu of a Driver's License (DL)"

- a. US Born: DL and Social Security Card, Birth Certificate, or US Passport.
- b. Born Abroad as US Citizen: DL and Birth Certificate Abroad or US Passport.
- c. Born in another Country: DL and Employment Card, Resident Card, or Visa with 194.
- d. US Citizen Naturalized: DL and US Passport or Naturalization Certificate.
