NEW BUSINESS:

1. <u>City of Buena Park : Request for Consistency Determination for the proposed Zoning Text</u> Amendment and Development Agreement for Airport Inn Apartments

The City of Buena Park is proposing a Zoning Text Amendment and Development Agreement for Airport Inn Apartments, a Permanent Supportive Housing project, located at 8180 Commonwealth Avenue. The project would convert a 60-room motel into a 57-unit permanent supportive housing project for chronically homeless individuals, along with a manager's unit, a new community/office building and site improvements with an outdoor recreational area.

Recommendation:

That the Commission find the proposed Zoning Text Amendment and Development Agreement for Airport Inn Apartments to be Consistent with the *AELUP for FMA* and the *AELUP for Heliports* with the following conditions:

- 1) That the City agrees to refer to the ALUC any future Development Agreement requests for Permanent Supportive Housing in the Neighborhood Commercial Overlay between Stanton and Indiana Avenues.
- 2) The City will submit to the ALUC the final noise report after sound attenuation.
- 3) That the City require all designated outdoor common or recreational areas within the development have outdoor signage informing the public of the presence of operating aircraft.
