JOHN WAYNE AIRPORT POSTS AUGUST 2020 STATISTICS

SANTA ANA, Calif. - Airline passenger traffic at John Wayne Airport decreased in August 2020 as compared with August 2019. In August 2020, the Airport served 266,986 passengers, a decrease of 71.7% when compared with the August 2019 passenger traffic count of 942,385.

Commercial aircraft operations decreased 50.1% and commuter aircraft operations increased 0.6% when compared with August 2019 levels.

Total aircraft operations decreased in August 2020 as compared with the same month in 2019. In August 2020, there were 22,963 total aircraft operations (take-offs and landings), a 23.3% decrease compared to 29,921 total aircraft operations in August 2019.

General aviation activity, which accounted for 80.7% of the total aircraft operations during August 2020, decreased 13.8% when compared with August 2019.

The top three airlines in August 2020 based on passenger count were Southwest Airlines (105,264), American Airlines (61,382) and United Airlines (33,118).

During the meeting held on September 17, 2020, the Airport Land Use Commission (ALUC) for Orange County considered the subject residential subdivision and the associated General Plan Amendment. The matter was duly discussed, moved, seconded, and carried unanimously by the Commission to find the proposed Shvetz Residential Subdivision and associated General Plan Amendment for 2400 Santiago Drive to be Consistent with the *Airport Environs Land Use Plan for John Wayne Airport (AELUP for JWA)* with the condition that all buyers, lessees, and renters be provided written "Notice of Airport in Vicinity" as described in *AELUP for JWA* Section 3.3.6 and California Business and Professions Code Section 11010:

"This property is presently located in the vicinity of an airport, within what is known as an airport influence area. For that reason, the property may be subject to some of the annoyances or inconveniences associated with proximity to airport operations (for example: noise, vibration, or odors). Individual sensitivities to those annoyances can vary from person to person. You may wish to consider what airport annoyances, if any, are associated with the property before you complete your purchase and determine whether they are acceptable to you."
