Noise Abatement at JWA

JWA is one of the most noise sensitive airports in the United States. The Airport is located in the center of Orange County, California with residential areas in close proximity.

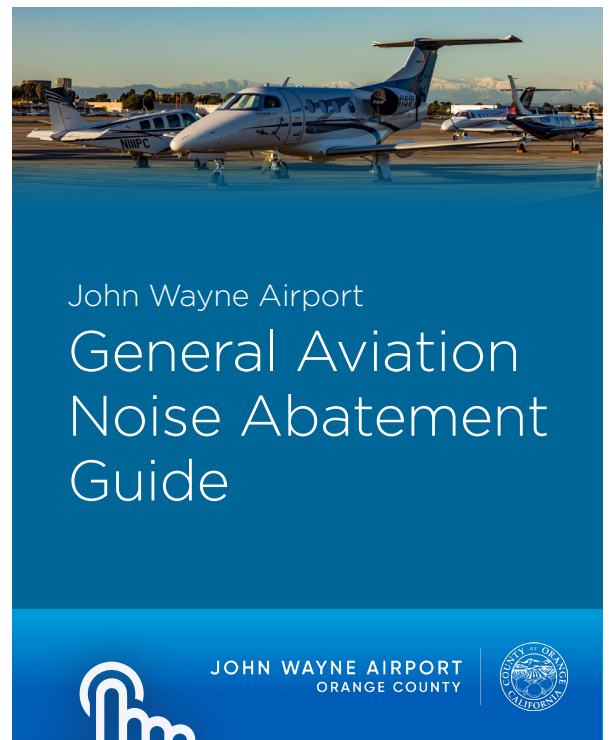
To mitigate potential noise impacts from aircraft operations and to enhance compatibility with surrounding communities, the Airport maintains some of the most stringent noise regulations in the country.

JWA's General Noise Abatement Guide

The General Aviation Noise Ordinance (GANO) has been adopted by the County of Orange to regulate the hours of operation and the maximum permitted noise levels associated with general aviation operations. Compliance with the GANO is mandatory unless deviations are made necessary by Air Traffic Control instructions, a medical or in-flight emergency, or other safety considerations.

Fly Friendly Pilot Instructions

Voluntary NBAA Standard NADP

1. Climb at maximum practical rate not to exceed V₂+20 KIAS (maximum pitch attitude 20 degrees) to 1,000 feet AAE in takeoff configuration at takeoff thrust.
2. At 1,000 feet AAE, begin acceleration to final segment speed (VFS or VFTO) and retract flaps. Reduce to a quiet climb power setting while maintaining a rate of climb necessary to comply with IFR departure procedure, otherwise a maximum of 1,000 FPM at an airspeed not to exceed 190 KIAS, until reaching 3,000 feet AAE. If ATC requires level off prior to reaching NADP termination height, power must be reduced so as not to exceed 190 KIAS.
3. Above 3,000 feet AAE resume normal climb schedule with gradual application of climb power.
4. Ensure compliance with applicable IFR climb and airspeed requirements at all times.

Make necessary deviations as instructed by Air Traffic Control, as required by a medical or in-flight emergency, or other safety considerations. Noise abatement procedures should only be utilized when requirements for safe operation of aircraft have been met.

John Wayne Airport (JWA) introduces Fly Friendly (FF), an annual award program for General Aviation (GA) jet operators. Developed to minimize aircraft noise impacts on surrounding communities, this program provides both education and recognition. GA jet operators practice voluntary efforts to safely reduce measurable noise levels and pollution in Orange County, California.

The Fly Friendly program focuses on:

- Educating aircraft operators on best practices in noise reduction at and around the Airport, as measured by JWA Noise Monitoring Stations
- Encouraging operators to voluntarily adopt additional aviation practices and technologies that support pollution reduction
- Scoring applicable voluntary actions and spotlighting winners through an annual award program

The Fly Friendly program follows a scoring system that awards points to operators based on categories that support safe reduction of measurable noise and pollution. Scoring areas include Quietest Departures and Nighttime Noise Reduction. Bonus points can also be earned for Environmental Stewardship and Sustainability measures and/or engaging in outreach and educational efforts.
