## FORMAT

Artwork must be the original and completed **ONLY** on 11" x 17" paper – **NO EXCEPTIONS**. Use of copy-righted material is not permitted. Three-dimensional work will not be accepted. Artwork **MUST NOT** be framed, mounted or outlined with any type of border. Artwork must be single sheet of 11" x 17" paper. No collaborations permitted; only one student may work on a submitted art work. No digital art will be accepted. **DO NOT FOLD OR ROLL ARTWORK.**

## MEDIA

**PERMITTED:** Artwork may be crayon, watercolor, acrylic or oil paint, color pencil, indelible marker pen, felt-tip pen, soft ballpoint pen or any similar indelible medium.  
**NOT PERMITTED:** Digital art, pencil, charcoal, oil crayon, chalk, glitter or collage work involving the use of photocopies.

## ARTIST INFORMATION

**ONLY ONE ENTRY PER STUDENT ALLOWED:** Student's full name, address, age, birth date, grade and phone number. School's name with address and phone number. All phone numbers must be clearly printed on the attached form which, when completed, should then be **securely** affixed to the back of the artwork. This required information is kept secure and not available to the public.

## PARENTS - TEACHERS

**PLEASE NOTE:** Artwork submitted with incomplete or illegible entry forms will not be judged. The parent, guardian or teacher must certify works sent to this contest are the student's original artwork by signing the attached entry form in the space provided, acknowledging you have read and understand ALL these rules.

## TEACHERS PLEASE NOTE

An additional separate list that includes, **on each sheet**, school name and phone number, teacher name(s) student names, ages, and grades **must** accompany each classroom's submittal. Please be sure to number each student information sheet and include the total number of those sheets, for JWA information processing.

## AGES

JWA contest entries will be judged at each grade level from kindergarten through Grade 12, in two categories:

Category I: Grades K – 6  
Category II: Grades 7 – 12

## RETURN OF ARTWORK

## ELIGIBILITY

**All K-12 students residing in Orange County who attend public schools, private schools, or are homeschooled in Orange County school districts may submit artwork for this contest.**

## ENTRY CHECK LIST

- Entry form information is fully completed.
- Entry form is securely taped on all four sides to back of artwork.
- Entry form is signed and box is checked at "I have read all the rules" line, by the parent, guardian or teacher.
- All printing is clear and legible.

Only K-12 students who attend or are homeschooled in the Orange County school districts may submit artwork for this contest.

## 11 REASONS TO BE DISQUALIFIED

1. Entry form does not have **ALL** blanks filled-in.
2. Entry form printing is illegible.
3. Entry form is not securely taped to back of artwork.
4. Entry form is not signed by a parent, guardian or teacher.
5. Artwork is digital or done in pencil, chalk, charcoal, oil crayon or collage of photo-copies.
6. Artwork is not 11" x 17".
7. Artwork has been folded or rolled.
8. Artwork has border on it.
9. Artwork paper is mounted on another piece of paper, board or material.
10. Artwork was created by more than one student.
11. More than one entry per student.

This form must be **detached** at dashed line and **taped** on all 4 edges and corners, onto the backside of artwork submitted for judging. Please follow example sketch.

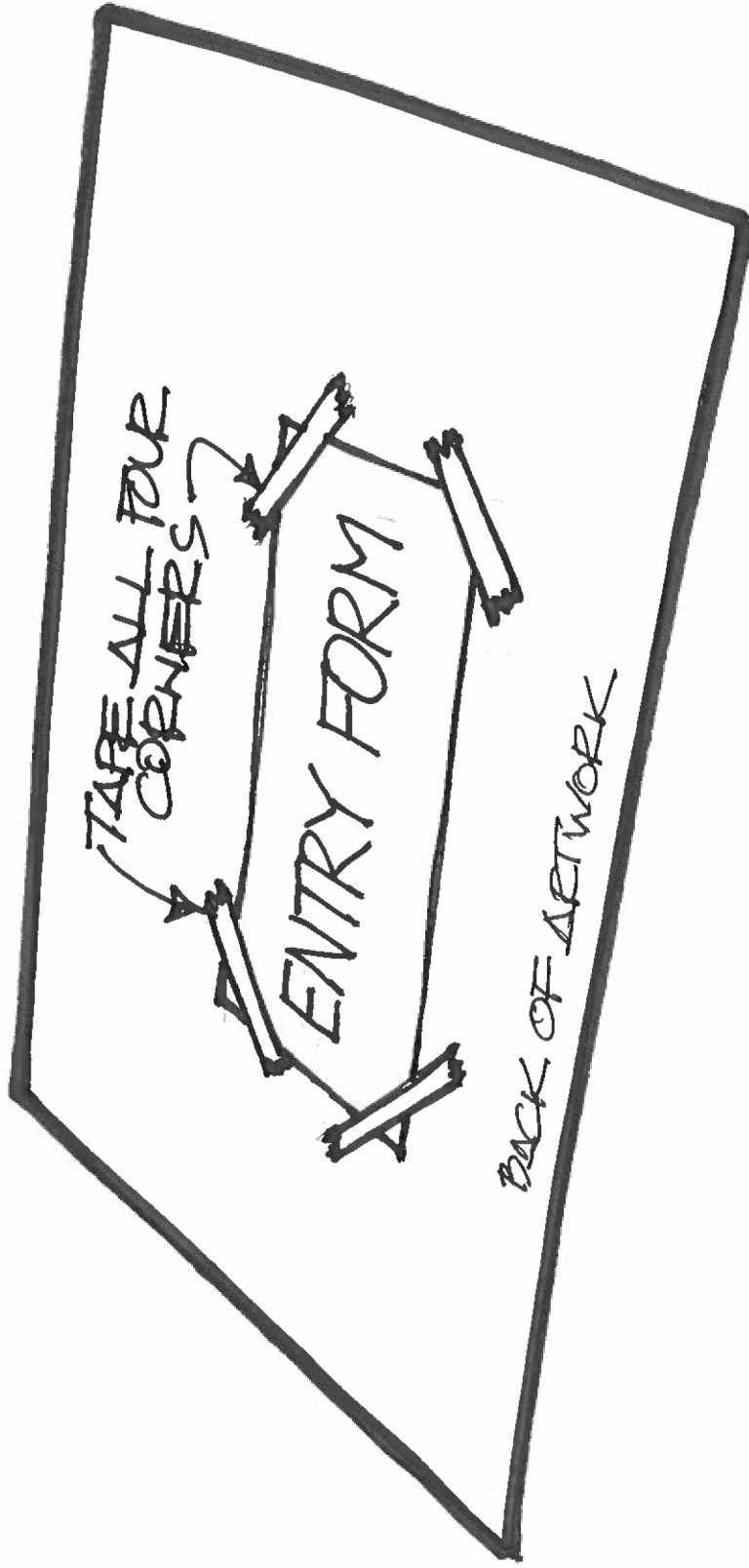
