2. County of Orange Proposed Land Use Element Amendment LU-2201 and Zoning Code Amendment CA 22-01

The County of Orange has submitted its proposed General Plan Amendment LU 22-01 (Land Use Element) and Zoning Code Amendment CA 22-01 (Housing Opportunities Overlay District and Technical Revisions) for a consistency review.

Recommendation:

That the Commission find the proposed County of Orange General Plan Amendment LU 22-01 (Land Use Element) and Zoning Code Amendment CA 22-01 to be consistent with the *AELUPs for JWA*, *JFTB Los Alamitos and FMA*.

3. Update on City of Seal Beach Overrule and Consistency Status

On August 29, 2022 the City of Seal Beach City Council took action to overrule the Airport land Use Commission's inconsistency determination on the City's Housing Element Update. The update will include a discussion of Inconsistent Agency terminology and the overrule process.
